About The Turning Point

The Turning Point, established in 1982, is the only rape crisis center in Collin County. We serve both Dallas and Collin County communities. To meet the growing needs of our community, The Turning Point continues to expand and improve our free services.

Our mission is to provide counseling, education, and advocacy for those impacted by sexual violence.

Our vision is to deliver the highest quality of comprehensive treatment services for survivors of all forms of sexual violence and to set the standard for prevention education that promotes social change to end bullying, sexual harassment, and sexual violence.

Our Services

Over 80% of our donated funds are spent on direct client services!

With your help, we will provide:

- Crisis advocacy services via a 24 Hour Hotline staffed with trained volunteers to inform and support persons affected directly or indirectly by sexual violence.
 - **In 2016, we took 1,441 hotline calls from those in crisis.**
- Hospital advocacy through trained volunteers to provide emotional support and Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners to perform forensic investigations which may not otherwise be available at certain hospitals.
 - **In 2016, we made 374 hospital calls for survivors of sexual violence, an increase of 30% from 2015.**
- Counseling services for survivors of sexual violence and their friends and family.
 - **In 2016, we provided 1067 counseling and intake sessions to clients in our treatment program.**
- Educational programs that raise awareness and emphasize the effects of bullying, sexual harassment, and sexualized violence to individuals, schools, law enforcement, medical practitioners, and businesses.
 - **In 2016, we reached 26,810 individuals through our community outreach program and 11,573 students participated in our education programs.**
